

IMPEACHMENT PROBLEM 7: ARTHUR JACKSON

Assume that Mr. Jackson has testified at trial on direct examination that he never spoke to George Avery before he left the night of the fire.

(a) For Mismo, conduct a cross-examination and impeachment of Mr. Jackson.

(b) For Flinders, conduct a redirect examination to the extent necessary to rehabilitate.

CONFIRM the lie told at trial:

You have testified today that you did not speak to George Avery when you left on the night of the fire.

Impeachment:

Isn't it true that you have previously testified that you did in fact talk to George Avery before you left that night?

If "no", CREDIT his deposition.

CONFRONT him with his prior inconsistent statement at page 20, lines 10-11.
