Criminal Law Terms: Quiz

State of mind	a.	A crime that does not require a mens rea. It is a crime regardless of intent.
Mens Rea	b.	The person who commits the crime.
Strict liability	c.	Failing to perform an act required by criminal law. You must be physically able to perform that act.
Felony	d.	An effort to commit a crime but does not result in completion. Must involve a "substantial step."
Misdemeanor	e.	What you are *thinking*.
Principal	f.	An act that is open or clear.
Accomplice	g.	A person who *voluntarily* helps another person commit a crime. Is usually present or directly aiding in the crime.
Accessory before the fact	h.	The Latin term for a guilty state of mind.
Accessory after the fact	i.	Crimes that are committed in *preparation* of committing another crime.
Crime of omission	j.	An agreement between two or more people to commit a crime, along with a "substantial" step to towards committing that crime.
Inchoate crimes	k.	The act of requesting or strongly urging some to do something. In criminal law, the "something" must be illegal to be considered a crime.
Solicitation	I.	A person who, knowing a crime was committed, assists in concealing the crime or criminal.
Attempt	m.	A criminal offense punishable by a prison sentence of one year or less.
Conspiracy	n.	A person who encourages, orders, or helps plan a crime.
Overt act	0.	A serious criminal offense punishable by a prison sentence of more than one year
