Mark Farley is a preeminent national workplace safety and crisis management lawyer. Many of the largest global energy companies and chemical manufacturers designate him as their crisis response counsel. Mark has served in lead attorney roles for some of the most significant US industrial accidents in the last 20 years. His practice is focused on developing a new standard for how companies respond to the investigations by the CSB, OSHA, and the US EPA that often occur in the aftermath of a workplace disaster.

Mark was one of the lead partners supporting the work of the BP US Refineries Independent Safety Review Panel, which investigated the corporate safety culture and oversight at BP's North American refineries on behalf of an independent panel of experts chaired by former US Secretary of State James A.
