

Students in Need of Appetizing Confections and Kolaches of Spring 2013

Section I: An Act to provide breakfast to the Section C Party Animals.

Section II. S.N.A.C.K. (Students in Need of Appetizing Confections and Kolaches)

Section III: The purpose of this Bill is to spend \$100 provided by Prof. Hester on Do-nuts & Kolaches from Shipley's.

Section IV: As used in this act--

- (1) "Do-nuts" means the traditional plain sugar-glazed yeast pastries.
- (2) "Kolaches" means bread products of Polish origin traditionally stuffed with sausage and/or cheese.
- (3) "Shipley's" means any do-nut store by that name located in the Houston area.
- (4) "Vegetarian" means food products that do not contain animal products, excluding eggs and cheese.
- (5) "Prof. Hester" means Professor Tracy Hester, Assistant Professor of Law.

Section V: This Bill provides for a ratio of one Kolache for every two Do-nuts on Jan.30 at 10:30 am, delivered by Prof. Hester or a person he delegates. The full \$100 will be spent on Do-nuts and Kolaches. Any spare change left over shall be deposited in the 2013 Party Animal Fund.

Section VI: If Vegetarian Kolaches are available, five Vegetarian Kolaches must be purchased. This provision does not affect the ratio of Do-nuts to Kolaches. People who do not consume meat or pork products must have first selection of Vegetarian Kolaches.

Section VII: This statute shall terminate upon its execution.

Section VIII: This statute shall become effective immediately.
