- Law school or Undergraduate transcript
- A letter of recommendation (Must be a professor)
- Proof of Acceptance at Houston Law School (for the Joshua and Dorothy Williams Only)
- Resume highlighting any previous participation in JTB programming and/or work towards diversity and inclusion

Scholarship applications are due on April 24, 2026, at 11:59 PM, and awardees will be notified in July 2026.
