Karen C. Tseng is Senior Vice President and Chief Integration Officer at Harris Health System, where she oversees the population health and care integration platforms for the country's fourth largest safety net system. Ms. Tseng also serves as a fellow in health policy at Rice University's Baker Institute and on the boards of the Greater Houston Healthconnect and Houston's HOPE Clinic. She has spent the last 17 years focused on increasing health care access and affordability for underserved populations and developing cross-sector initiatives to improve health and reduce disparities. Prior roles include serving as the founding policy director for the Health Policy Commission, as a commissioner on Massachusetts's Asian American Commission, on the Center for Health Information and Analysis's Oversight Council, and as senior health care counsel for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, where she led the state's modernization of more than \$700 million in annual community benefits expenditures to focus on six statewide social determinants of health. Ms. Tseng has taught at Tufts University School of Medicine and at Harvard Law School and is an honors graduate of Harvard Law School and Harvard College.
