The Fellow is assigned to the House or Senate committees that consider all health legislation presented during the session or to an office of a member who focuses primarily on health policy issues. This is a full-time position that requires living in Austin. Fellows prepare policy analysis, briefing materials, and perform other tasks as requested by their legislative supervisors. Excellent research and writing skills required. Legislative Fellows have a unique opportunity to impact health policy development in Texas and to forge strong networks for future public policy work.
