Erin C. Fuse Brown, J.D., M.P.H., is a Professor of Health Services, Policy & Practice at Brown University School of Public Health, the director of the Health Policy & Law Lab, and a faculty member of the Center for Advancing Health Policy through Research. She specializes in health law and policy, and her research focuses on health care finance, consolidation, corporatization, competition, financialization, and private equity investment. Professor Fuse Brown's work has influenced health policy at the state and national levels. Prior to Brown, she was the Catherine C. Henson Professor of Law and Director of the Center for Law, Health & Society at Georgia State University College of Law.

Hayden Rooke-Ley is a Senior Fellow at the Brown University School of Public Health. His scholarship and expertise focuses on corporate consolidation in health care, Medicare and Medicaid financing, and labor and workforce issues in the health sector. He has published extensively in leading journals, including the New England Journal of Medicine and Journal of the American Medical Association (JAMA), and advises state and federal policymakers, enforcement agencies, and other health care stakeholders. Previously, he served as a health policy advisor in Congress and earned his J.D. from Stanford Law School.
